CHURCH SERVICE –

There will be a church service held on Sunday, 8:00 am at the arena

<u>GRAND ENTRY</u> –

Thursday & Saturday morning there will grand entry with sponsor flags & American flag

SPECIAL GROUND RULES =

- 1. Thirty (30) second time limits will be in effect for all times events.
- 2. In all roping events, the one loop rule will be in effect.
- 3. Western attire is required for contestants at all times in all arenas along with your state issued back number.
- 4. NO air horns are allowed in any arena.

AWARDS –

- 1. All Around Cowboy & Cowgirl will receive Gist buckles & \$1,000 scholarships paid out at the rodeo
- 2. Reserve All Around Cowboy & Cowgirl will receive Gist buckles
- 3. Event winners will receive Gist buckles
- 4. Event reserve winners will receive a Cinch certificate

In case of a tie, Champion awards will be duplicated, reserve champion ties will be broken by a flip of a coin

PAYOUT -

Jackpot will be paid on each go as well as the average. The money for the first go will be ready to pickup 1 hour after the 1st go is complete. The money for the second go will be ready to pick up within 30 minutes of the event completing. If you are not going to be present on Sunday afternoon we can mail your money to you or send it via your State designee (national director, president, secretary). Any contestant with payout must fill out a W9 before receiving their check.

<u>ADMISSION & STALLS - (You are responsible for this)</u>

Admission at the door will be \$10.00 per day.

<u>HORSE STALLS</u> – (You are responsible for this) Go to www.ghsra.com, Go to the Southeastern Showdown tab or use the links above under Admission. High School will be in BARN 1 and overflow to Barn 2 if necessary.

Stall reservations must be received no later than Friday, October 24, 2025. EACH CONTESTANT MUST PUT THEIR HORSE OR HORSES IN A STALL WITH ONLY ONE HORSE PER STALL. NO HORSES CAN BE TIED TO TRAILERS AND NO PENS CAN BE SET UP AT TRAILERS. THIS IS A GNFA RULE.

Stall cost is \$150.00 per stall for the 4 nights in advance and needs to be pre ordered through one of the links above. Each stall comes with 3 bales of shavings that will be in your stall when you arrive.

If you need more than the 3 bales of shaving's you can purchase them from the fairgrounds on their website https://www.gnfa.com/

If you want to rent stall mats, contact Lisa Slaton at 478-952-6251. She will coordinate with the fairgrounds to have the mats in your stall when you arrive. https://www.greenbrokefarmservices.com/services.php

GHSRA will assign stalls according to the reservations and all States will be together if received in time. High School will be in Barn 1 and overflow to Barn 2 if necessary.

If you have a late stall request you may or may not be with your State or your other stalls. Stalls will be \$190.00 after October 25, 2025. If you need stalls after October 25th you must contact Leisa Haselrig at sesdrodeosecretary@gmail.com or 423-305-3692.

Stall fees will not be refunded without a Vet or medical excuse.

RV HOOK-UPS = (You are responsible for this)

The GNFA does not park states together If you want to park with a particular person or group you must make your reservations together*

There are plenty of campsites with full hook-ups. Arrange directly with the Georgia National

Fairgrounds and Agricenter to make your reservations. Your reservation can be made through their website, https://www.gnfa.com/ No generators are allowed.

30 Amp - \$50.00 per night + tax 50 Amp - \$65.00 per night +tax

The Agricenter has a security gate with personnel on duty 24 hours. In an emergency you can call 1-478-988-6557. They are there only for assistance and have no connections with the rodeo and cannot answer any questions regarding the rodeo.

HORSE HEALTH PAPERS =

Be sure you have a *NEGATIVE COGGINS* on your horse. Also, check with your state regarding health papers required when crossing state lines, to and from the rodeo.

CINCH Team Challenge Rodeo -

This is a separate rodeo held during the Southeastern Showdown. This is not a mandatory event. SCHSRA would like to send a team for this. We will decide the team by who is leading each event after Marshville. If you are leading more than 1 event you will need to choose which event you would like to compete in. Entry fees for this rodeo are \$25 per event. Team roping is \$25 for the team.

This will be held Friday night November 7th at 7:00 pm.

If you are leading an event with the SCHSRA and choose not to compete in the Cinch Cup please let us know so that we can roll down to the next eligible contestant.

HOOEY JUNIOR PATRIOT

Barrels & Poles will only be offered in high school

High School: SESD will once again be a Hooey Junior Patriot Qualifier for the following events:Barrels, Poles, Team Roping, Tie Down Roping, Breakaway, Goat Tying, Steer Wrestling. You must enter online with the Junior Patriot prior to SESD starting. Please check their website to make sure you don't miss their deadline. You will qualify by NHSRA rules on the 2 runs total, except for barrels and poles which will be calculated on your first run. High School contestants must enter in the 19 and under category, 15 and under will not be offered for high school contestants

NEW THIS YEAR:

The American will award aggregate winners exemption (no fees) entries to the Eastern Regional Semi-Finals in Lexington, KY in the following events: Bareback, Saddle Bronc, Bulls, Team Roping, Tie Down, Breakaway, Barrels and Steer Wrestling.

Contestants will also be able to enter the above events as a qualifier for the Eastern Regional Semi-Finals of the American.

The Jackpot arena events for Barrels, Team Roping and Breakaway are also Eastern Regional qualifiers. More information to come in the next few weeks.
