# SCHSRA

## MEMBERSHIP ENROLLMENT

Membership enrollment must be completed on-line on the National High School Rodeo Association website (<https://nhsra.equestevent.com>)

**\*\*NATIONAL DUES MUST BE PAID ONLINE\*\***

Returning members will log in to the National website and enter your login information to update your file.

\*New members please watch the tutorial on how to make an account\*

# Rodeo Call -In

- **Rodeo Call -In is one of the most Important procedures of the rodeo**
- **Every** contestant who wants to enter the rodeo for the weekend, must call in to the rodeo secretary/designee in order to enter the rodeo
- Rodeo call-in is conducted on **MONDAY** before the rodeo is scheduled, from **7:00 pm – 9:00 pm**. NO LATE CALL-IN'S WILL BE ACCEPTED!  
(Ex. If the rodeo is scheduled for Friday, Sept. 11, Call In will be Monday, Sept. 7, 7pm-9pm)
- If you miss call-in on Monday night (7:00 pm-9:00 pm), you will **NOT** be eligible to enter the rodeo that weekend
- If the rodeo is scheduled for more than one (1) day, you must specify at call-in:
  - What events are you entering? (HS- Bareback, Saddle Bronc, Breakaway, Tie Down, Steer Wrestling, Team Roping, Barrels, Poles, Goat Tying, Bull Riding)
  - What days are you entering? (If it is a 2 day rodeo & you do not specify you want to enter both days, you will only be entered for the 1<sup>st</sup> day)
  - If you are entering Team Roping, please specify if you would like to be **eligible to be a draw partner (if needed)**. You can only use a Draw Partner **4 times** in the rodeo season (year).
- Slack is only request taken at call-in. Rodeo show cannot be requested, it is randomly drawn for each event and the show will be filled before slack can be filled.
- Check the SCHSRA website ([www.schsrodeo.org](http://www.schsrodeo.org)) for rodeo schedule & call-in phone number

# Stock Draw

- The **Stock** Rodeo Draw is the “line up or run schedule” for the rodeo stock in each event
- The rodeo stock draw is done on the rodeo grounds after the arrival of the stock
- After the arrival of the rodeo stock, the stock contractor meets with the rodeo secretary/designee and delivers the stock identifier numbers for each animal
- The contestant is assigned their rodeo stock for the event by the rodeo secretary and a rodeo judge who use the rodeo draw sheet order to randomly draw the stock. The stock identifier numbers drawn by the judge are entered on the rodeo draw sheet for the event
- The Rodeo Draw sheet listing the stock numbers for the contestants is posted at the Rodeo check-in area 30 minutes prior to the start of the rodeo show
- The slack portion of the rodeo stock draw is posted at the end of the rodeo show

# Rodeo Draw

- The Rodeo Draw is the “line up” for the rodeo events
- The draw is broken down into rodeo events
- The rodeo draw is compiled from the contestant call-in’s to the rodeo secretary/designee
- The running order for each event consists of the following steps: 1) The contestants are entered into their requested events in an Excel computer program 2) The contestants are then randomly sorted by the computer. 3) **The computer sort creates the running order for each event.** To be fair to each contestant, the running order is done by computer and not by hand. This process is completed for each rodeo event
- There are a certain number of show entries for each event, if there are more entries for an event than allowed in show, those entries will be entered in the slack portion of the rodeo. Slack is ran after the rodeo on Fri and at times, can be ran on a Sat afternoon before the Sat evening rodeo. Slack run times are scheduled by the producers of the rodeo.
- Slack can be requested at call-in, but cannot be guaranteed. The show will be filled before a slack request can be honored
- **Show request cannot be honored since the draw is computer generated**
- Rodeo draws are posted on the SCHSRA website by Wednesday after call-in

# Event Points

- Each rodeo event accumulates event points (1-10)
- Event points are designated by the run times in each event
- The first 10 positions in the final running order of the event will receive event points with the 1<sup>st</sup> place contestant receiving 10 points, then each place after will receive points until zero is reached
- Event points are posted on the SCHSRA website the following week after the rodeo show
- Cumulative event points are also documented and posted on the SCHSRA website for the All Around Cowboy Award and the All Around Cowgirl Award

## SCHSRA RODEO CHECK-IN

**You may check in for the rodeo AFTER you have received your Membership Packet and your back number at your first rodeo of the season.**

### **WE WILL COLLECT THE FOLLOWING AT RODEO CHECK-IN:**

**1) School Form (Signed by School Official AND Parent)**

*You will need ONE (1) school form for each rodeo weekend*

**2) Rodeo Entry Fee(s) - \$30 per contestant per event**

**ALL FEES MUST BE PAID BEFORE YOU WILL BE ALLOWED TO RODEO**
