College Scholarship Program

Introduction

The South Carolina high School Rodeo Association (SCHSRA) is a member of the National High School Rodeo Association (NHSRA) whose purpose and aim is among others “to promote high school rodeo...to promote the highest type conduct and sportsmanship... to encourage any student to continue in school as a regularly enrolled student and improve their education.” In following this philosophy, the SCHSRA will sponsor a scholarship program for its student members who meet the contestant qualifications set forth in the rule book and the additional qualifications set forth by the SCHSRA Board of Directors through the Scholarship Committee.

Program

The scholarship is open to all qualified graduating seniors of the SCHSRA who enroll in a university, college, or trade school to continue their education after graduating from high school. Each will receive an equal amount from the fund, plus an additional amount for each year of full membership up to a maximum of four years. The exact amount of the scholarships will be determined by the Board of Directors based on the amount of money in the fund at year’s end. This amount will vary from year to year to reflect how successful the fund raising was for that year.

Awards will be available once to an applicant for the year immediately following graduation from his high school, and thereby, the last eligible year to compete in High School Rodeo.

The scholarship will be paid directly to the institution when the recipient processes enrollment.

No late applications will be considered.

Qualifications

Applicants must have the following qualifications and/or follow the directions below:

1. The applicant must be an active member of the SCHSRA as outlined in the current NHSRA Rule Book for at least the entire year immediately preceding high school graduation, enrollment in a university, college, and trade school, and receipt of the scholarship.
2. The applicant must be enrolled as a full time student in an accredited university, college, or trade school for the year that the scholarship is awarded.
3. Applicants must have the entire application filled out correctly and completely. In addition, any other informational or special request asked for in the application must be submitted attached to the application when turned in.
4. Applicants must have participated in a specific number of times in the special fund raising projects that will be conducted through-out the year. The fund raising projects will be announced and the senior contestant and/or their representative will need to make sure that the chairman of the Scholarship Committee is aware of their involvement and their date of their involvement. The more money that is raised for the scholarship fund will mean the more money there will be to award in scholarships.

1. A letter of acceptance from the institution of higher learning that you will be attending or some other official documentation proving acceptance.
2. A short write-up of all your extra-curricular activities.
3. A short write-up of how you have gained, grown from, and learned by participating in high school rodeo.
4. A one-page essay (double spaced) outlining your future plans and goals and any other information you think important to assist the selection in evaluating your application.
5. Two letters of recommendation. One should be from your local high school (typed and on letter head), and the other your choice.
6. A recent head and shoulders photograph (non-returnable) that can serve any publicity needs.

Complete applications should be submitted in a sealed envelope with your **name** and **Scholarship Application** clearly marked on the outside. Applications are to be turned in to the state secretary of the SCHSRA or the Chairman of the Scholarship Committee, by the end of sign-in at the state finals rodeo. No late applications will be considered. In addition, make sure all information requested is supplied and all questions fully answered. If this application is not completely and accurately filled out your chance of receiving a scholarship will be jeopardized.
